Physical exercise is important for preschoolers—it supports their physical, mental, and social growth. Here are simple ways to add movement to your day:

Big Movement Play

Build strength and coordination with tag, Follow the Leader, jumping over objects, or hopping like animals.

Music & Movement

Sing action songs like Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes, play Freeze Dance, or march and skip to music.

Outdoor Play

Take nature walks, visit a playground, garden, or play with bubbles and chalk.
